

We want to encourage groups to make room for personal growth

- Encourage those in your group to lead the prayer the following week. [Pray about who could lead the prayers for the coming week]
- Bring a scripture to set the tone for the time of prayer. Conversational style of prayer [Taking a topic and allowing room for others to add to the prayer point].
- This style allows Holy Spirit to high-light things to others, we only have part of the puzzle piece and not the full picture. It's an honouring way of praying. "Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct

him?" But we have the mind of Christ, New Livina Translation 1 Cor 2v16
